

ASTRONAUT TRAINING CAMP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Scholarships, Award Amounts, and Recipients

These two scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in the 4th, 5th, 6th, or 7th grades during the 2020 - 2021 school year. The scholarships are:

- I.L. Friedman Scholarship (\$250.00)
- Frances Friedman Scholarship (\$250.00)

Guidelines

- Those students who received a scholarship in 2021 are ineligible this year.
- Students will write a letter, no longer than one page, stating why they should be awarded a scholarship for STAR Camp.
- The letter *must include a separate cover sheet*, which includes the following information:
 - Student's Name
 - School and District
 - Grade
 - Teacher
- Student's name, school, grade, and teacher ***should be listed on the cover sheet only, not in the letter itself.***

Important Information (please read carefully)

- Letters must be received no later than April 30, 2022.
- Any letters not following the above mentioned guidelines will be disqualified.
- A scholarship committee will read and evaluate all entries.
- The committee will decide who receives the scholarships no later than May 10, 2022.
- The scholarship committee will also choose a first, second, third, and fourth alternate. These alternates will be given the scholarship award in the event any of the winners cannot attend.
- The scholarship committee members will know only the grade of the letter writer. All other information such as name, school, and teacher will be withheld.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than May 13, 2022.
- Scholarship winners will be expected to write a thank you letter to the Brundige family while they are at camp.
- Scholarship winners are *reserved* a place in the Astronaut Training Camp on June 28-July 1, 2022. Please do not register online if you won't be attending camp without the scholarship.
- *Scholarships can only be used for Astronaut Training Camp.* If the scholarship winner is unable to attend this camp, an alternate will be chosen.
- The remaining camp tuition above the \$250.00 award (\$50.00) must be paid by the recipient, parents, or family members no later than June 1, 2022.
- Letters will not be returned.
